Terms of Attendance

Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals

June 04-05, 2018 in Freiburg

1 Object of this contract

1.1 The Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals will be held in Freiburg from June 04-05, 2018.

The event will be held in English.

These General Terms and Conditions apply to all attendees.

1.2 The organizer of the Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals is the Fraunhofer Institute for Solar Energy Systems (Fraunhofer ISE), Heidenhofstr. 2, 79110 Freiburg, Germany ("Organizer").

2 Registration; Conclusion of contract; Admission badge

2.1 Attendees should register online, via the official event website <https://ptl-workshop.pse-co.de> ("Event Website").

2.2 Completion of online registration is tantamount to submission of an offer to attend the Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals. A contract in relation to attendance is considered established when the offer is accepted by the organizer. Acceptance is indicated via an email confirming your registration. Please note that registrations cannot be confirmed unless the attendance fee has been paid in full.

2.3 The deadline for registration is as follows (subject to modification by the organizer):

2.4 Places are limited and will be attributed in the order of registration. The organizer is entitled to reject further applications once the maximum number of attendees has been reached.

2.5 You will be given a name badge on arrival. Your first and last names, and your company/institute name, will be printed on this badge. Your badge entitles you to admission to all events and services as booked. Badges are not transferable. Please wear your badge at all times and ensure it is clearly visible.

3 Program

3.1 The event program is published on the event website / the event flyer.

3.2 The organizer reserves the right to change the order or content of the program if obliged to do so for an important reason. The organizer cannot be held responsible for changes to the program, and reserves the right to cancel, delay or change presentations, to add new presentations or to change speakers. The organizer will make every effort to give timely notice of changes to the order or content of the program on the event website.

3.3 Changes to the order or content of the program made due to an important reason shall not entitle attendees to a reduction in the attendance fee.

4 Attendance fee, payments

4.1 The attendance fee is payable in advance, by credit card (Visa or Master Card). The payment process is managed by PSE Conferences & Consulting GmbH on behalf of, and for the account of, the organizer. The online payment system is provided in partnership with B+S Card Service GmbH and the "Verified by Visa" (VbV) and "MasterCard Secure Code" (MSC) security systems. Payments are to be made in Euros. The attendee is responsible for paying any bank transaction fees which may exceptionally be charged in connection with processing of the payment.

4.2 Attendees will receive confirmation by email following registration and payment of the attendance fee. Please contact hemming@pse-co.de if you do not receive a confirmation email within 48 hours. Please note that there is no entitlement to attend without confirmation or proof of payment of attendance fee.

4.3 Registration for the Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals includes:

4.4 The cost of overnight accommodation is not included in the attendance fee. Attendees are responsible for booking their own accommodation.

5 Cancellation by attendees

5.1 There shall be no entitlement to cancel or terminate this contract.

5.2 If you are unable to attend the event – for whatever reason – you will be entitled to the following attendance fee reductions:

5.2.1 50% of your attendance fee will be refunded, if you inform the organizer of non-attendance up to and including April 15, 2018.

5.2.2 25% of your attendance fee will be refunded, if you inform the organizer of non-attendance up to and including May 11, 2018.

5.2.3 No refund will be made if you inform the organizer of non-attendance after May 11, 2018.

5.2.4 The cost of the Workshop dinner is not refundable.

5.3 Where the attendance fee has already been paid, a refund will be made as per the terms of 5.2 above within two months of the end of the conference. Any transaction fees incurred in connection with refunds shall be paid by the attendee.

5.5 You may nominate an alternative attendee any time up to the start of the event. Please contact the Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals organization team as soon as possible if you wish to send an alternative attendee. Tickets are not transferable at the event itself. Attendance fees will not be refunded for no-shows or early departures.

6 Confirmation and visas

6.1 Your registration will not become valid until all attendance fees have been paid and you have received a confirmation email from the organizing office, with invoice in attachment. Attendees are advised to have this confirmation with them for presentation at the event registration desk.

6.2 Visas

Attendees are responsible for contacting a German embassy or consulate for all information about visas. Please ensure you allow enough time to obtain a visa if necessary.

6.3 Letter of invitation

Official letters of invitation will be dispatched to all attendees who have registered and paid their attendance fee in full. An automatic invitation letter will be sent together with the registration confirmation. Please address any queries in good time by email to Maria Hemming (hemming@pse-co.de). Please note that the organizers of the Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals will not contact embassies on behalf of attendees.

The letter of invitation does not imply any financial obligations for the event organizer. All costs in connection with the visa process are to be paid by the attendee.

7 Cancellation of the event by the event organizer

Attendance fees will not be due if the event has to be cancelled for reasons attributable to the organizer. Payments which have already been made will be refunded.

If the event has to be postponed or cancelled for reasons beyond the organizer's control (force majeure), or due to situations not attributable to false intentions or gross negligence on the part of the organizer, the organizer cannot be held responsible for prejudice, costs or losses such as travel and accommodation, or other financial losses.

Under these circumstances the event organizer reserves the right either to refund all attendance fees in their entirety, or to refund attendance fees after deduction of costs incurred in connection with event suppliers.

8 Data protection

The personal data of attendees will be recorded in an event database. Credit card information will NOT be saved in this database. Email addresses may be used to send out information about the Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals or to inform you about a future Workshops. They may also be provided to the organizer of the next Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals. Attendees' personal data will not be provided to third parties. 9 Images of the event; Images of attendees; Attendee contributions

9.1 The shooting and use of visual material (e.g. photographs, films) is permitted for private purposes only. All commercial use is prohibited without the event organizer's prior written agreement.

9.2 During the event and fringe program, the organizer will collect visual material for documentation purposes, for simultaneous or subsequent reporting, to promote the event and to announce upcoming Workshop - Perspectives on Power-to-Liquids and Power-to-Chemicals and will provide third parties (including the press) with such material. If you appear in such footage, the event organizer shall ensure that your personal rights are not breached during the use and commercialization of such visual material.

10 Liability

10.1 The liability of the organizer, of his legal representatives and agents for breach of duty and tort shall be limited to intent and gross negligence. In the event of breaches of duties that are fundamental to the contract (cardinal duties), i.e. duties whose fulfillment is essential for the proper performance of the contract, and which the contracting parties may typically expect to be met, the event organizer, his legal representatives and agents shall also be liable for slight negligence. In this case, liability shall be limited to foreseeable damage typical for this type of contract. There shall be no liability for indirect damage, consequential damage or lost profits.

10.2 The organizer, his legal representatives and agents shall not be liable in the event of burglary or theft. The attendee shall be liable for all damage caused by him, or by objects in his possession.

10.3 These limitations of liability shall not apply in cases of injury to life, body and health of human beings, and for liability under product liability law.

11 Applicable law, Place of jurisdiction

11.1 All claims arising out of or in connection with this contractual relationship shall be subject to German law to the exclusion of the provisions of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sales of Goods (CISG), otherwise known as the UN Sales Convention.

11.2 The place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising out of or in connection with this contract is Munich.

12 Final provisions

12.1 If one or more provisions in these terms of attendance is or becomes invalid, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

12.2 Amendments and additions to these terms of attendance must be made in writing.
